A cerebral angiography to conquer sudden blindness... A first of its kind treatment type and scale in the Konkan region

A 33 years old man from Susheri, Khed admitted with history of fall with sudden loss of vision. Thorough investigations commenced and cerebral angiography was performed. It was observed that a huge blood clot blocked the flow of blood through one of the arteries in the brain. There was complete occlusion of internal carotid artery. He also had hyper-homocysteinemia.

A cerebral angiography was performed by the team of doctors led by Dr. Amit Sahu (interventional radiologist) with Radiology team at BKL Walawalkar Hospital.

The treatment of this type and scale was the first of its kind in this Konkan region. The patient is progressing well after the critical procedure. Thanks to the skilled medical professionals who performed the surgery, along with advanced medical technologies in hospital have been significantly serving poor patients in this rural area.
